Heading north on SH10 go 6km past the Kerikeri turn-off to get to Waipapa.

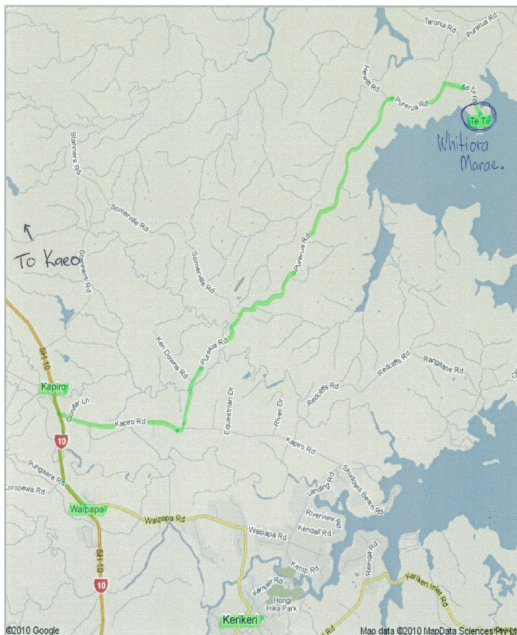
2km north of Waipapa, on SH10, turn right into Kapiro Road.
